

Where's the Money ?



All registered campus organizations are eligible to apply for special funding for their programs or events. Keep in mind that we have over 400 groups competing for the same money and funds are limited. Money is not available for general operating expenses, only for activities. For your convenience, the same Student Program Funding Application can be used for all of the sources listed in this publication. **Please refer to www.asuci.uci.edu for the Student Program Funding Application.**

MAJOR CAMPUS FUNDING SOURCES

A. ASUCI Student Programming

B. Multicultural Programs Committee (MPC)

- The maximum funds that can be allocated to any program is \$200. Applications must be submitted to the Cross-Cultural Center office by 4:00PM on the Friday of the deadline date. A representative from the organization must be present at the next MPC meeting following the submittal deadline. Meetings are held in the Cross-Cultural Center BOARD Room on the second Wednesday of the month, 10:00AM-11:00AM.

C. Dean's Fund

- Funding Request Forms must be submitted online by 3 p.m. of deadline dates. No in-person presentations.
- The maximum amount allocated to any group is \$400.
- Meetings are held within 1 week of submittal deadlines.

D. Community Service Funding Board

Sponsored by: Center for Service in Action

- Funding is available to student organizations that demonstrate plans for hands-on community service projects or programs. The maximum funds that can be allocated to any program is \$200. Applications must be submitted online to the ASUCI website by 4:00pm on the application deadline. - A student representative must attend the CSFB meeting following the submittal deadline, to present the organization's funding need. Meetings are held from 11am-12pm on the second Wednesday of the month.

E. Health Education Promoting Alcohol Responsibility Through You (P.A.R.T.Y.) Mini Grants

- Student organizations can apply for up to \$100.
- Up to thirty organizations will be funded.
- Completed Forms are submitted online.
- 80% of your organization's membership needs to complete a one-hour social hosting seminar.
- Funds may not be used for the purchase of alcohol.

F. UCI Alumni Association Funds (UCIAA)

The UCI Alumni Association will award funds from \$100-\$300 per program to a UCI campus organization sponsoring one of the following:

- The incorporation of alumni participation into the event program such as an alumni panel or alumni speaker.
- Anticipated alumni attendance that meets or exceeds twenty confirmed alumni attendees.
- Event planning that incorporates the participation and collaboration of alumni of the identified campus organization.
- Groups accepting UCIAA funds are required to provide event program, attendance list and photos that may be used in UCIAA or campus publications.
- Funding is limited. You are advised to submit your requests for review at least 6 weeks prior to the event date. Submissions are reviewed the first Monday of each month. Organizations will be notified on the status and/or award amount within three business days from review. Contact Dianna Fisher (949) 824-4552 for additional information.

GUIDELINES

- Present the entire budget and any supplemental material from previous years.
- Operating and/or any on-going general expenses of an organization will not be funded by any of these campus funding sources.
- It is highly recommended that you meet with one of the campus program advisors below before submitting your proposals online.

- Receipts for each funded program must be submitted within 30 days of the event. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- Upon conclusion of the program/event, a completed evaluation form must be returned to each source from which you received funding.
- No funding will be awarded for events scheduled during summer quarter.
- IMPORTANT:** Specific submittal guidelines and criteria may apply to each funding source and are available from the appropriate office.
- RECOMMENDATION:** To facilitate reimbursements, student organizations applying for funding are strongly encouraged to establish an ASUCI financial services club account.
